Eph.5:22-24, 33

Submit- Set oneself under  
Reverence- Terrified, affrighted, afraid  
(respect see 1Pet.3:6)

Col.3:18

Fit- That that is becoming.

1Pet.3:1-6

Subjection- willingly and habitual.(Eph.5:22)  
Behold- close attention  
Conversation- Behavior  
Fear- Terror? (respect)  
Chaste- modest,(Tit.2:5, 1Tim.2:9)  
Adorn- Polish, embellish  
Meek- Not easily provoked, easy going  
(2Tim.2:25; Gal.6:1; Mt.11:29)  
Quiet- mild, gentle, peaceable, tranquil  
Afraid- Fear, vs.2 and Eph.5:33  
Amazement- quaking terror, panic.

NOTE. Fear and afraid og 1Pet.3:2,6 is the same word as reverence of Eph.5:33. Eph.5:33 is a summary of vs.22-24; therefore context shows respectful subjection. 1Pet.3:6 also shows this.(not afraid with terror)

Tit.2:3-5

Holiness- Reverent behavior, demeanor-  
Not false accusers- slanderers  
Not given to much wine-enslaved  
(Ch.3:3; Rom.6:16; 2Pet.2:19)

Teachers of good things- Demeanor and words.  
Teach the Young Women- Train, influence, persuade,  
encourage, counsel, discipline, school, curb,  
correct, control, moderate.

Sober- wise

Love their husbands- (Phileo) Friend, Like

Love their children- same as above

Discreet- Prudent, good judgement in conduct and speech,  
careful in conduct.

Chaste- pure from carnality, modest

Keepers at home- workers or stayers at home,domestic Good- Kind, good nature, thoughtful of others. Obedient to their own husbands-
